Regular Meeting
October 21, 2024

Present: Mayor Joan Collins, Deputy Mayor Leni Binder, Trustees Ronald Kates, Asher Weiss.
Absent: Yaakov Levine.

Also Present: Attorney Jeffrey Kaplan, Brenda Cohn, Valerie Brown, and Myra Bennett.

Mayor Collins opened the meeting at 12:30 pm.

A motion was presented by Trustee Binder, seconded by Trustee Kates to accept the Minutes of October 7, 2024, as presented. Unanimous.

A motion was presented by Trustee Kates, seconded by Trustee Weiss, to pay bills on General Fund Abstract in the amount of \$15,464.22, Water Fund Abstract in the amount of \$7,150.87, and Sewer Fund Abstract in the amount of \$35,042.40. Unanimous.

There were no public comments.

Steve Valestro from H2O Innovations reported that Sewer Plant is running well. Chemical pumps have arrived for the wells. Some of the water meters are reaching the end of their lives, and some of the replacement meters are giving wrong readings, due to the decimal points; the Water Department and the Village Office staff are working on a solution. The hydrant flushing will be on November 17th through the 23rd. Leak Detection will be working on these dates to see if we can find leaks.

Mayor Collins inquired how the Saperstein water situation is going; Mr. Valestro replied that he has an appointment with Mr. Saperstein tomorrow, for water testing, he will report back to the Village Board.

A motion was presented by Trustee Binder, seconded by Trustee Weiss, to approve a one-year electric contract with Constellation through the Mega Agreement November 1, 2024 through October 31, 2025. Unanimous.

Ms. Cohn reported that the Village is in the process of switching banks. The office will be sending out the unpaid tax notices.

Jim Gerrard from Fusco Engineering reported that the Building Department has issued tickets to several residents for violations on their properties; some are complying with the cleanups, the ones that don't will get second tickets; and if they still don't comply they will then have to come to court.

Mayor Collins announced that the Kiwanis Club will be holding a Trunk or Treat in the Green Avenue Parking Lot on Sunday, October 27, 2024, the hours will be 2:00 – 4:00 pm.


